

Small Grants Funding Announcement

Local Suicide and Self Harm Initiatives

The CLEAR Project in conjunction with the Public Health Agency invite applications addressing local suicide prevention / self harm initiatives in the West as outline in the NI Suicide Prevention Strategy – Protect Life (A Shared Vision) which was launched in October 2006.

Funding can be applied for under two separate themes.

Theme one: Service Delivery

A number of awards are available to support the delivery of services up to the value of £7,500. Priority will be given to groups whose primary focus is suicide prevention within the overall context of promoting good mental health and tackling the main contributing factors of suicide / self-harm.

Theme Two: Service Development

A number of awards are available to support organisational development up to the value of £5,000. Organisations that participated in the CLEAR mapping exercise are eligible to apply for this theme. Priority will be given, but is not limited to, proposals that demonstrate an ability to meet development needs outlined in the tailored individual reports provided through the CLEAR mapping exercise.
